Libertyville Days: MVPs of '23

This year's Libertyville Days Festival, MVPs of '23 is June 15-18, 2023.

The festivities include Lake County's largest and most spectacular parade, featuring community floats, marching bands, horses, and more, which will be on **Saturday, June 17th. The parade steps off at 10:00 a.m. from the Metra train station and travels south on Milwaukee Avenue to Rockland Road.** This year's parade grand marshal is Christina Riek, ICU Nurse at Advocate Condell Medical Center.

The Libertyville Days Festival is organized by the Libertyville Civic Center Foundation, with help from members of the Junior Woman's Club, and Knights of Columbus, who donate hundreds of volunteer hours each year in support of the Libertyville Civic Center Foundation. The Festival also includes children's activities, a variety of food vendors, and a Main Stage with musical entertainment throughout the weekend. New this year is a VIP reserved viewing area within the Beer Garden and Church Street Eats locations. Stormwater Projects Update – June 2023

STORMWATER FUNDS AT WORK The Engineering Division staff continues to work on completing the flood reduction projects included in the Village's Master Stormwater Management Plan.



The overall timeline of proposed improvements laid out in the Master Plan is still on schedule. In collaboration with Lake County and state agencies, staff has secured over \$7.6 million dollars in grant funding for stormwater projects and has additional grant applications pending. The Village has recently invested over \$28M in stormwater projects.

Below is a brief description of each of the active Master Stormwater Management Plan projects:

Rockland Corridor–Nearing completion: New storm sewer pipe infrastructure was installed in the vicinity of Lincoln, Fourth, and Seventh Avenue, connecting into the sewer system recently installed underneath Rockland Road.

Highlands Phase 1–Nearing completion: The southern portion of Nicholas Dowden Park south was excavated to provide detention storage for large storm events. The park amenities (softball fields, batting cages, storage building, parking stalls, sidewalks, and ice rinks) have been replaced to modern standards, and an underdrain system will drain the fields to be dry between storms.

Highlands Phase 2–Under construction through 2023: New storm sewer pipe infrastructure to be installed in the vicinity of Crane, Dymond, Rockland, Burdick, Ames, Austin, etc. The additional sewer capacity will drain storm runoff from the streets to the Dowden Park detention storage area.

Copeland Manor–In design, construction scheduled 2025: New storm sewer pipe infrastructure to be installed in the vicinity of Glendale, Fourth, Seventh, and the north side of Copeland Manor Elementary School. The improved system will better convey runoff from the large upstream tributary area to the Des Plaines River.

Kristin & Loyola–Completed Spring 2023: A portion of storm sewer was upgraded near Kristin Drive and Loyola Drive to reduce the risk of structure flooding.

Mosquito Control

As the weather gets warmer, inevitably, mosquitoes join us for summer fun. To help combat these pesky bugs, the Village contracts with Clarke Environmental, Inc. for mosquito control.

Much of the control activity is focused on “pre-hatch” treatment, killing the mosquito to larvae before they hatch. These activities include treating breeding areas, using catch basin applications, and monitoring of mosquito levels from light traps.

This year the Village will be utilizing the Earth Right program provided by Clarke Environmental. The Earth Right program is intended to provide an option for communities to align public health mosquito control with public preference for more environmentally-friendly control products and application materials.

In spite of the efforts to reduce mosquito larvae, when conditions are right, mosquitoes may reach a nuisance level. When this occurs, the Village may schedule a community-wide spray to control the adult mosquito population. The decision to spray is based on a number of factors including light trap levels, nuisance complaints, and weather conditions.


Spraying is done for the entire community. We are not able to spray single neighborhoods. Due to changing weather conditions, it is difficult to provide advance notice of spraying. However, depending on the amount of advance notice we receive, we will use the Village website, Facebook page, or the Friday e-newsletter to notify the community.

2023 Joint Road Rehabilitation Program

The Village will again be participating in a Joint Bid Road program with Mundelein and Libertyville Township Road District to continue to receive advantageous pricing by achieving “economics of scale” from larger contract quantities. This is the 5th year the Village will be participating in the Joint Road Program with its neighbors. The contractor for the project is Peter Baker & Son Co. Inc.

The program involves removal of curbs and gutters (extent varies depending upon the street), as well as pavement patching, removal (grinding) of the pavement surface, and placement of new binder and sur-

face (“shave and pave”). Residents will be notified when work begins on their street and if work will impede access to their driveways. The following roadways are scheduled for this season:

- Green Tree Parkway from Dawes Street to Garfield Avenue
- Green Tree Parkway cul de sac
- Pembroke Road from Dawes Street to W. Golf Road
- East Golf Road from Milwaukee Avenue to Harvard Lane
- Prairie Avenue from S. Sunnyside Avenue to E. Rockland Road
- Bartlett Terrace from Appley Avenue to Appley Avenue
- Camelot Lane from Ridgeway Lane to Dead End
- Ridgeway Lane from US Rte. 176 to Camelot Lane
