

METHODOLOGY

As part of the process to nominate the Downtown Historic District to the National Register of Historic Places, the Village of Libertyville has completed an update to the 2016 Historic Resources Survey of the Libertyville downtown in July 2024. This update, conducted by Ramsey Historic Consultants, gathered new information and current photographs of the buildings within the proposed district.

CHANGES

The following properties have been reclassified.

Non-Contributing to Contributing:

- 107-109 E. Cook Street
- 510-514 N. Milwaukee Avenue
- 624 N. Milwaukee Ave.
- Liberty Theater

Contributing to Non-Contributing:

- 111 School Street
- 510-514 N Milwaukee Avenue*
- 547-551 N Milwaukee Ave*
- 125 W Church St*
- 120 E Cook Ave*

Boundary Adjustments:

- Sunrise park was removed from the boundaries by the State Historic Preservation Office in order to tighten the boundaries.
- Minor adjustments made around the edges to refine the boundary shape.

Non-Contributing properties do not meet the criteria for historic designation, often due to newer construction or significant alterations and, therefore, are not eligible for the same benefits that historic properties receive under the National Register of Historic Places.
