CURRENT STATION CONDITION


Detective Bureau

- Inadequate space for day to day operations
- Disruptions during phone interviews and case review
- Does not account for growth in personnel




LOCKER ROOMS & EMPLOYEE SPACES

- Female locker room has exceeded its current capacity
- Lockers are undersized and does not properly store required equipment
- Lack of Wellness Room




FRONT LOBBY ACCESS & PRIVACY

- Lobby is small and does not have private report room
- No public meeting room
- Layout can require victims and suspects to cross paths
- Outdated structure limits functionality and modernization



PRISONER PROCESSING & SAFETY


- Arrestees have to be moved up 2 flights of stairs to booking room
- Suspects cannot be securely separated during interrogations
- Jail cells lack modern safety features
- Lacks holding area or bullpen



Modern police work demands secure, functional, and adaptable spaces that support everything from emergency response to mental health interventions. Aging facilities can no longer accommodate the technology, staffing, and training needs required for effective 21st-century policing.

OFFICE SPACE & EVIDENCE STORAGE

- Personnel have exceeded current office spaces
- Lack of dedicated training area
- Limited space for processing/storing vehicles and evidence
- Limited evidence storage



GEAR STORAGE & GARAGE BAYS

- Limited storage for bicycles, tech, and specialty equipment
- Inadequate indoor parking
- No secure ambulance access in garage
- No centralized location for firearms and ammunition



FINANCING

The Village anticipates utilizing a dedicated funding source to construct the new station. Since 2022, the Village has collected a 1/2% percent local sales tax which has been dedicated to funding a New Building Fund for the purpose of improving Village facilities. The revenue collected is estimated to be approximately \$1,600,000 annually. This funding model is intended to remove the burden of a new police station from local property taxpayers. Additionally revenue from the sale of the Libertyville Sports Complex properties have been transferred into the New Building Fund to support this initiative.
